

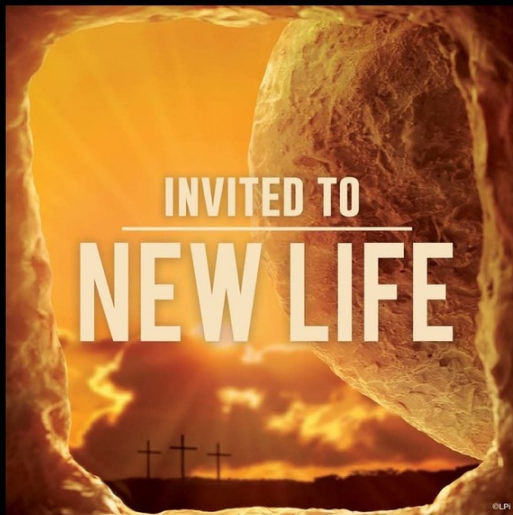

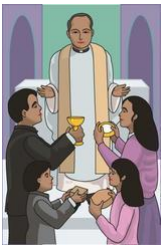
PARISH CENTER
